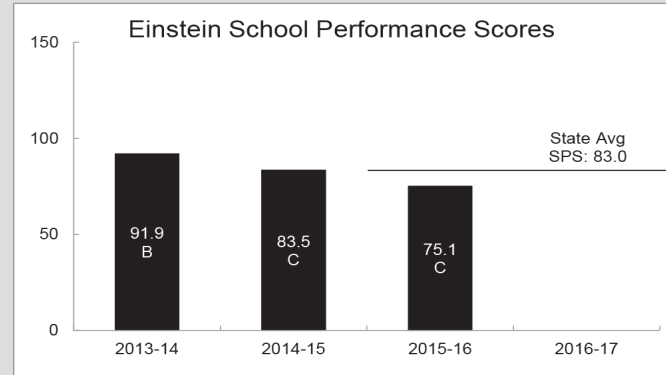

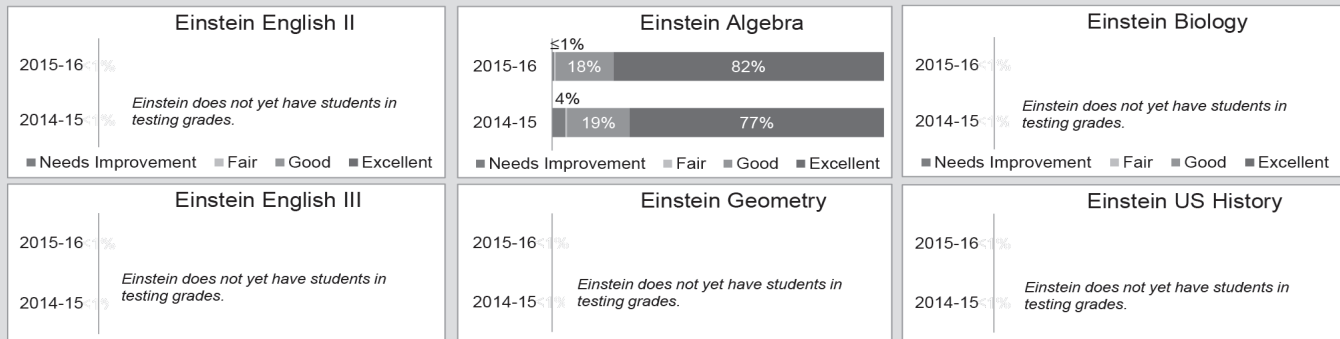
School Performance Score

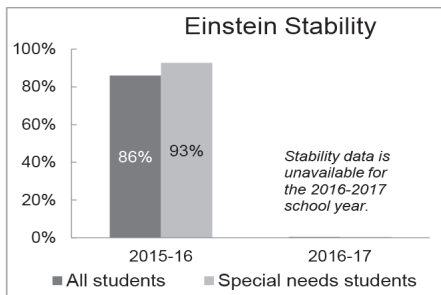

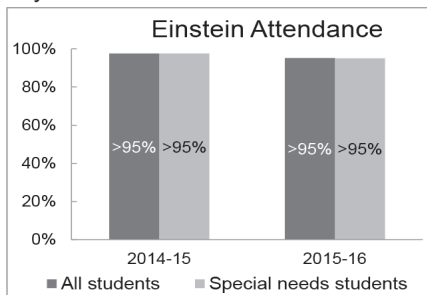
Student Stability
