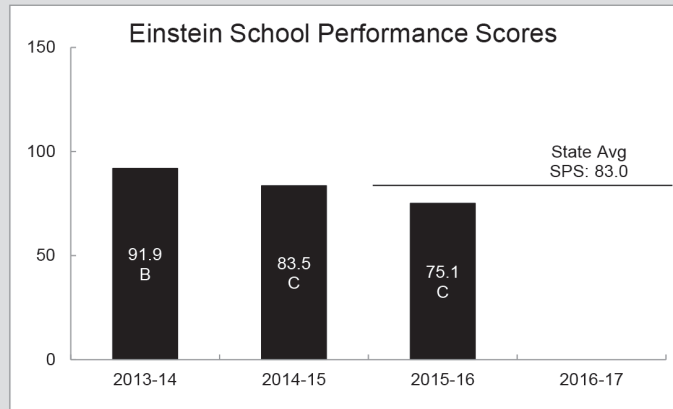

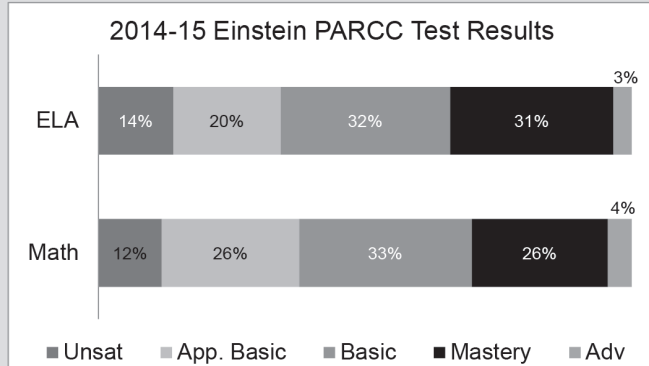
School Performance Score

The SPS is calculated each year based on how students perform on certain standardized tests. See page 17 for more information.



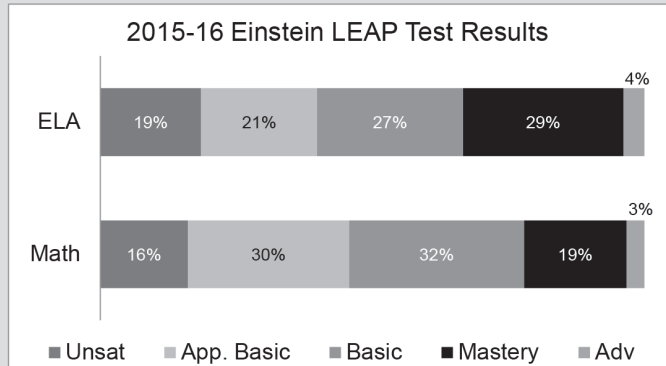
Spring 2015 PARCC Test Results: Grades 3 - 8

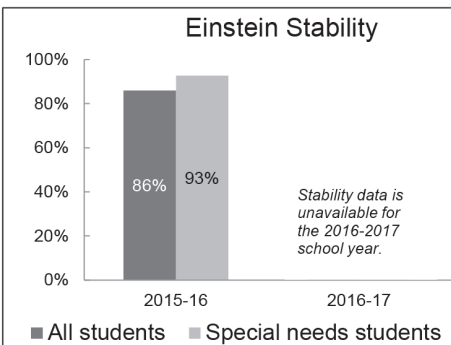
Spring 2016 LEAP Test Results: Grades 3 - 8

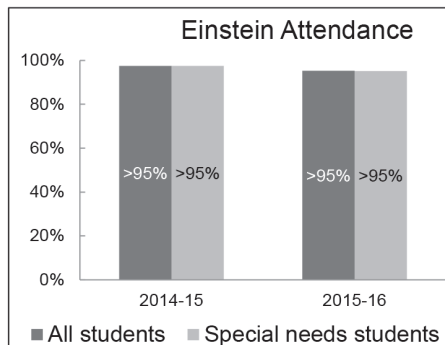
Student Stability
