

Did You Know?

Listing more choices is the best way to get a placement

Families who selected 7 or more choices on their Main Round application have nearly a 100% match rate. If you need to enroll in a new school, whether you are new to New Orleans, new to high school, or because you know you want to transfer, list as many choices as you can in the Main Round. Many in-demand schools will fill up and may not have seats available after the Main Round.



OneApp means citywide options, with neighborhood priority

Last year, 93% of families who applied to 3 or more schools within their neighborhood received a placement to one of those schools. If you would prefer to go to a school close to your home, make sure you list those schools higher on your OneApp. If you would prefer to go to a school outside of your neighborhood, you can also do that! Most OneApp schools give priority to applicants who live in the neighborhood, but students can apply from all over the city.

Your choices may change...but so can your application

You may have already submitted your OneApp, but changed your mind or done some more research on your school options. It isn't too late! If you would like to change your application before the deadline, you can do so any time before the deadline. Simply log back into your OneApp account on oneapp.force.com and make any necessary edits. Remember: you can only alter your OneApp before the deadline!

You can research all your school options -- online!

EnrollNOLA.org provides detailed profiles of all public schools in New Orleans, as well as tools to help narrow down your school list, or understand how the placement process works. Researching your options is the best way to make sure your school choices meet your child's and family's needs. You shouldn't apply if you want to stay at your current school

If you are placed at any of the choices you list on your application, you will lose the spot you hold at your current school. That is why we encourage you to only apply to schools you *prefer more* than your current school. Once you lose your seat at a prior school, there's no guarantee you can return. Exercise caution and decisiveness when deciding to submit a OneApp
