

Applying for High School

Students who will be attending 9th grade for the first time next year need to submit a OneApp. Here's how:



1) Research your high school options

Determine what's important to you in selecting a high school. Next, visit EnrollNOLA.org and explore all participating high schools. You can view the profiles of schools you're interested and see what they offer.

2) Select your top school choices

Once you've determined what you want in a school, narrow down your choices. You can select up to 12 choices. Make sure you're satisfied and wouldn't mind attending either of these schools. Remember, there are thousands of 8th graders who are applying for 9th grade, too. However, there are a limited number of 9th grade seats in each school. So you should select a wide range of schools.

3) Submit a OneApp

Go to EnrollNOLA.org and submit an application for next school year. List all your choices on your OneApp. You should rank your most preferred school as your first choice. It's best to submit an application during the Main Round when schools have the most seats available. OneApp will **NOT** place you in a school that's not listed on your application, so it's important to list as many choices as possible.

4) Placement Results

You will receive your placement results in April via email. They will also be available in the parent portal, oneapp.force.com. The notification you receive will include instructions on your next steps.
